DSAGSL is seeking a Programs Intern for the spring 2018 semester. Working with the Program Coordinator, Interns gain experience in program planning, scheduling, and preparation. Interns will have direct interaction and communication with families, as well as work directly with individuals with Down syndrome participating in the program. In addition, Interns gain experience in a non-profit setting.

The responsibilities will include, but are not limited to, the following:

 - These include Therapeutic Playgroups, workshops for parents, and social & recreational events
- Work with Program Coordinator on presentation logistics including:
 - Person-first presentations at schools and community groups
 - Education Specialist training
 - Disability-inclusion presentation

This internship is unpaid. DSAGSL will assist students with earning academic credit for their work. Schedule is flexible based on student availability.
